

# Youth Ministry Semester Recap

Hi there parish family! (Lauren Wright here, from our St. Pat's Youth Ministry). As our year of ministry comes to a close, I wanted to share with you two of my favorite ways we were able to see the Lord move this year.

As many of you know, for the first time this year we had the opportunity to offer a weekend-long Confirmation retreat for all of our 8th grade students preparing to receive the Sacrament. Through the graces of Confession, Mass, and Adoration we were able to watch as our students who showed up on Friday, reserved and uncertain, encountered the transformative love of the Holy Spirit. The shift in openness and freedom from Friday evening to Sunday afternoon was truly remarkable. And, even more important than that, we watched as that same openness was carried on to the day of their Confirmation.

Another way that we've seen the Lord work is through our amazing Adult Leader Team. Something we say a lot in our youth ministry is that the Lord is never outdone in generosity. Whenever we give our time and energy in service for the Lord, He always blesses us tenfold. Over this past year it has been a joy to see this play out in the lives of our adult volunteers who, in watching the Lord move in the lives of our students, have themselves experienced a renewal of their own faith.

Our aim is that our youth program not only helps transform the hearts of our students but also reaches into the greater parish community, blessing adults and families in their own relationship with Christ. It has truly been an incredible year of ministry, and we know that it would not have been possible without the support of our parish family so, as always, thank you! We can't wait to see what else the Lord has in store as we continue to grow as a ministry!
