From Fr. Arnold

Dear Parishioners.

These past few months, Msgr. Deutsch asked the parishioners to pray for my mom's health. And I would like to thank you for that because God heard your prayers. God extended the life of my mom to be with us for a while. As much as we want Mom to be with us for a long time, God has another plan for her. That's why, last Monday at 6:15 PM (PH Time), God called her to be with Him in heaven at the age of 81 years old. As my Dad told us: Nanay (Mommy) died peacefully, as if she just fall asleep. And that's another grace from God.

And now she is lying peacefully in our house, because that is traditional funeral wake practice in our hometown. You don't have to rent a funeral parlor, there is no viewing hours, the relatives, friends can stay at the wake as long as they want and there is an everyday prayer for the deceased. And there is a celebration of the Mass every day, if there is an available priest to celebrate it.

Tomorrow at around 5:45 PM here, I will leave for the Philippines to be with my family. All my brothers who are working in Abu Dhabi and Singapore with their family are there in our home now. I'm going home with a pain in my heart. Because every time I went to other place or country, they used to pick me up at the airport when I arrived. It's difficult and different now, because I will arrive home not seeing the smile of my mom and asking me: How's your trip? Are you tired? Did you enjoy your trip? Entering our home, what I will see is my mom lying inside the coffin and in a few days she will be going to a journey, a journey going back to her original destination, to the bosom of our Heavenly Father. She will be gone, but our love for her is forever.

So again, I'm asking for your prayers. Prayers for my safe trip going home and prayers for my family. So that in this moment of grief, what we will experience is the love of God and your support and kind words. I'll be coming back in the parish after almost two weeks on October 25, the same day I arrived here last year. And on October 28, 2023 at 10:30 AM at Crane Rd, as Msgr. Deutsch planned it, we will have a memorial Mass for my Mom. Feel free to attend and join us in the celebration of life in the Holy Eucharist.

We will surely miss my Mom. But when we think of my mom, it is not how she died that we remember,

but how she lived. I LOVED YOU NANAY LETTY. GOD BLESS YOU AND OUR FAMILY.

To Msgr. Deutsch, Fr. Pacer, all the Office Staff, and to all the Parishioners of St. Patrick Parish, my warmest gratitude for all the support and prayers that all of you showed to me and my family. May God bless you all.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We, the Catholic bishops of Illinois, write with a sense of urgency. Unless the General Assembly acts to renew the Invest in Kids scholarship program, more than 9,000 children currently relying on this program to attend a non-public school may have their educational path disrupted. Without an extension of the program in Illinois law now, no scholarships will be awarded for the school year that will begin in September 2024. Most of these children will have to leave the school their families determined was their best chance to receive a high-quality education in a safe and wholesome learning environment. This is an injustice that should and can be avoided, but only if the General Assembly acts when it reconvenes on October 24, 2023.

Invest in Kids has proven to be a beacon of hope for thousands of Illinois students and their families. Children receiving Invest in Kids scholarships come from lower-income families who could not otherwise afford tuition at the Catholic or another non-public school that is the best fit for their child. Childhood is a limited time in the life of a human being and primary and secondary education is not something that can be put off to some future date when it is convenient for adults. This is our one chance to offer these Illinois children a good start. Please help keep education options available and a brighter future possible by contacting your state senator and state representative and telling them to continue the Invest in Kids Program.

Since its inception six years ago, Invest in Kids has generated overwhelmingly positive results. Nearly 40,000 scholarships have been awarded to students attending non-public schools across Illinois. Demand for scholarships is very high - for every scholarship granted, three students are turned down due to lack of funds. Contrary to what you may have heard, this is not a voucher program, nor does it take state funds away from the public schools. These scholarships are funded through contributions from donors who receive a tax credit for their donation on their Illinois state income tax.

What can you do to help? Please contact your state senator and state representative to let them know of your support for extending the Invest in Kids tax credit scholarship program in Illinois. We also encourage you to urge your fellow parishioners to do the same. Our collective voice is vital to the continued help for Illinois families. 


