Giving Tree gifts and gift cards support the following local organizations:

Association for Individual Development (AID) serves over 5,700 children and adults with developmental, intellectual, physical and/or mental health challenges. AID operates community day centers in Elgin, Aurora, Batavia, and Yorkville; mental health outpatient clinics throughout the Fox Valley; supports over 500 individuals living in their own apartments; and more than 200 individuals in group homes scattered throughout the greater Fox Valley.

Catholic Charities in Rockford is a federation of several agencies throughout the 11 counties of the Diocese of Rockford, which delivers, coordinates and advocates for quality human services and programs touching almost every human need. Catholic Charities collaborates with parishes, as well as non-Catholic and Catholic partners, to build a compassionate and just society.

Corbella Clinic provides life-affirming, free and confidential medical and support services to women and couples during and after an unexpected pregnancy. Clients are given essentials for the baby such as clothes, diapers, formula, blankets, car seats and more. All services are offered in English and Spanish.

Fox Valley Food for Health provides healthy, nutrient-rich meals to individuals and families going through serious illness. Priority is given to individuals and families who are economically disadvantaged, to those with children, and to people living alone or without support. Most individuals and families are going through cancer treatment.

Fox Valley Hands of Hope provides compassionate guidance and support to children, families, and adults who are experiencing grief, loss, or life-threatening illness, at no cost to clients. Services include support groups, grief seminars, and individual grief counseling with a licensed clinician, individual support with a trained volunteer, as well as compassionate volunteer companions for nursing home, hospice, and cancer patients.

Marklund provides residential, educational, and therapeutic services to children, teens and adults with serious and profound developmental disabilities and special healthcare needs as well as those on the Autism spectrum. Marklund has 177 residents, plus more than 250 in the day services and day school programs.

St. Vincent de Paul Society provides temporary and immediate relief to the poor and those who are in need by feeding, clothing, housing, and healing individuals and families.


