From the Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

We recently set up a model of babies in the womb at various stages of growth. It's a great teaching model and very inspirational. I hope you'll take a moment to look at it and marvel at God creation of new life. I asked Jon Mielke, a member of our Pro-Life Committee, to give a short history of how we came to have these beautiful figures on display in the narthex:

"The fetal models that are being used in the display case currently at the Crane Road Church have been used by the Respect Life Committee for many years. Dr. Larry Johnson (The original Parish Respect Life Coordinator for St. Patrick) would purchase a booth for the "Fox Valley Pro-Life Coalition" at the Kane County Fair with volunteers from the Respect Life Committee along with others from local churches who would staff the booth to answer questions and promote life. The exhibit gave away free literature and foam 12-Week Fetal Models, presented the National Geographic "In The Womb" video, and had various other displays. One of the most popular displays was the lifelike fetal models showing the stages of fetal development. These models sparked many discussions with the fair visitors. However, the number of visitors to the Kane County Fair dropped off and the building where we presented our exhibit started attracting fewer and fewer visitors. So in 2019 the Respect Life Committee decided it was not effective to stage the exhibition.

In 2023, Msgr. Deutsch suggested some sort of fetal display that could be used to promote life at the two churches and at the school. The Respect Life Committee asked Dr. Johnson if he would consider lending the Fetal Model set to the Church and he graciously offered to donate the set to St. Patrick. With the donation of the fetal models we then needed a display case. Of course, the first choice was Webb Custom Carpentry. Jim agreed to make the display case and did a marvelous job creating the beautiful case out of oak and using 1/4" tempered

glass for safety. The display was designed to be at a height that even young children can view the models and is on wheels so that we can move the case to the school to be used to promote an understanding of fetal development."

I'm so grateful that we have this gift and want to thank Larry Johnson, Jon Mielke, Jim Webb, Sarah Swanson and the Pro-Life Committee for all they do to promote the sanctity of life from natural conception to natural death.






