Dear Parishioners,

Happy St. Patrick's day!

It's pretty special this year that St. Patrick's feast day falls on a Sunday. Because he is the patron of our parish, we are allowed to celebrate his feast day on Sunday (other parishes have to do the readings for the 5th Sunday of Lent, but we get to do all the prayers and readings for St. Patrick). But some others might be bummed because they were hoping to get a break from their Lenten fast on some other day of the week because they already take off Sunday. Don't worry, St. Joseph's Day is this upcoming Tuesday, and it's a solemnity, allowing you a pause from your fasting during the week.

But, I also want us to keep one thing in mind in the midst of our St. Pat's celebrations: the man himself. 




Sanctuary Series for Catholics




