

Happy Easter! Happy Spring! We are halfway through the Easter season. Could it be a better time to celebrate First Holy Communion for our parish second graders? It's not only on Christmas, birthdays, or Easter that we get gifts and feel joy. Every time we go to mass – every time we receive Jesus in the Eucharist – we receive the gifts of love, forgiveness, hope, and feel joy. Wow! Seeing our second graders receive Jesus for the first time – it's a great reminder of the gift we receive through the Eucharist. 






2025 Mass Intentions are Open
