

From the Pastor

MSGR. DAN DEUTSCH

Hi Parishioners.

I hope you're enjoying your summer and enjoying our longer days and warmer weather. In the midst of all this, the parish continues working hard to stay connected with you.

We recently began a parish/parent connection newsletter for school families to keep them aware of things in the parish that might interest them. These notes usually start with a small letter from me and then detail various parish or area activities. There are also links to our web pages, the bulletin, and homilies. These letters are sent via Flocknote and have received an open audience. For our Weekly Flocknote, over 70% of the people who receive them open them. This last week, I began listing the names of seven families from the School for whom I will be praying that particular week. It also gives the families who are mentioned or any School family who would like to take advantage of it a link to where they can let me know what they want me to pray for regarding them and their families. We have received many responses to that as well. In addition, we have been doing family rosaries with parents in the rosary garden outside of School, we have also been meeting with school families for a rosary one night per week in the school chapel. This last week, we also took a group of people up to Mundelein Seminary for the National Eucharistic Congress. The Eucharistic Procession went through Chicago and stopped at Mundelein for a youth night. There was mass and a Eucharistic procession around the seminary grounds. It was a perfect day and a beautiful evening to walk with our Lord. We have also begun our summer Alpha program, which has about 70 participants, and our youth bonfire nights throughout the summer. These are very well attended, with around 40 young people every Tuesday night. In 2 weeks, we will be journeying to a Steubenville youth conference in Missouri for one of the many summer youth conferences put on by Franciscan University every summer. We have two busloads of students going. Please pray that they have a great experience with their friends and a life-changing encounter with the Lord, who will continue to guide them through these formative years.

Thank you for all you do for the parish and making this such an exciting place for a priest to minister.






