From the Associate

FR. ARNOLD | PAROCHIAL VICAR



Hi Parishioners,

In July 2022, you've first heard that there would be a new priest from the Philippines coming and serve in St. Patrick Parish. That priest, me, Fr. Arnold, would be coming from the Diocese of Gumaca, in Quezon Province Philippines. And I knew there would be a question lingering in your mind: Where is the Diocese of Gumaca? Let this article answered your question.

The Diocese of Gumaca was erected on April 9, 1984, carved out from the Diocese of Lucena. Our first Bishop Emilio Z. Marquez, now retired. From 1984 up to the present, we have 29 Parishes and 3 Mission stations. As of 2021, the Total Population of the Diocese of Gumaca are 1,059,760. Eighty Five Percent (85%) of the total population (around 902,270 people) are baptized as Roman Catholics. Our diocese is also made up of mountainous areas. There are 70 active priests serving the diocese, 2 deacons 62 professed nuns, 14 lay missionaries, 5 professional Catechists and 879 volunteer catechists. The main aim of our diocese is to be more of a participatory church, aiming to form Basic Ecclesial Community in every parish. Bringing the Church to the people.

Now after 40 years, we are now continuing the dream of our late Bishop Victor C. Ocampo who died a year ago, to build a retirement home for the elderly and sick priests. We hope to complete our clergy retirement home next year as a legacy of Bishop Ocampo and as a celebration of our 40th Founding Anniversary next year as a Diocese.

It for this reason that our Diocesan Administrator, Rev. Fr. Ramon Uriarte, will be here in our Diocese to do a Mission Appeal as a means of completing the Retirement House for the Priest. Fr. Monching, as we usually call him, together with clergy of the Diocese of Gumaca, co-own this responsibility to see the completion of its edification. He will stay in our Parish while doing the mission appeal. He will be in our Parish from July 21 until July 31, 2024.

Let us pray for him and for the success of his mission. Thank you and God bless you all.

15th Sunday of Ordinary Time Meditation

By Father John Muir

Once I asked a fallen-away Catholic friend of mine what he remembered about the parish priest from his youth. He said, “He was a gentle, nice guy. Kind of vanilla. Kept to himself.” It struck me that he, perhaps like many, perceive Catholic priests as the following: lonely, harmless, and self-sufficient. As a challenge both to this perception (accurate or not) and to us priests who perhaps feel a pull in that uninspiring direction, stands the mighty image of what we see in the Gospel this Sunday.

Jesus sent out his apostles, “two-by-two, with power over demons, and without money belts.” Two-by-two: they enjoyed deep fellowship and brotherhood. Power over demons: they were anything but harmless. These men wielded enormous power against evil. Without money belts: they were not self-sufficient. They needed others to help them. Not lonely, but in community. Not harmless but armed with massive spiritual energy. Not self-sufficient, but poor and in need of help.

This is a challenge to me, and perhaps to all of us, living in a rich, secularized, and individualized culture. Do I embrace my priestly ministry in deep fellowship with other priests? Do I speak and act boldly to drive out evil where it is found? Do I live poorly and simply, trusting in the help of those around me even for basic needs? The fruitfulness of priestly ministry largely depends on these three traits. Let’s pray for all priests — and, by extension, all of us Christians — to live more like Jesus’ communal, poor, and powerful apostles.
