## From the Pastor

MSGR. DEUTSCH

Dear Parishioners,



It's still the Easter Season where we celebrate the rising of Christ from the dead (Passover) and move towards Pentecost(50 days) with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and the beginning of the Church. This follows the ancient Jewish cultural and liturgical calendar of Israel. In Israel Pentecost was a harvest festival with religious significance and took place 50 days after Passover. It was the celebration of the 2nd grain harvest as well celebration of the giving of the Law by God to Moses and Israel at Sinai. God takes care of their every need. He sustains them with food and his own life through freedom from slavery in Egypt at the first Passover. The gift of the bread or manna, the portable temple with the ark which contained the law and fire that goes before them to guide them on their way.

Our Pentecost is the celebration of what the old Jewish Pentecost pointed to. The grain, the bread of life is crushed on the cross at Passover. He is the Passover lamb sacrificed. 50 days later Pentecost comes with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on all Gods people. This fire guides us on our way as Christ the new temple leads us as the Church. He sustains us in this second harvest as the Eucharist. He is the New Manna! This Easter Season then is a time of continued joy and preparation as we await the celebration of the fire of the Holy Spirit to recreate us as disciples.

I write this while on my mandatory annual priest retreat. It's with Scott Hahn, John Bergsma and Ted Sri with 175 other priests in attendance. It's in Austin, Texas so we got to see the full eclipse. It was

amazing. When it reached totality, you could see the ray's coming out and even solar flares. We stood in the darkness and marveled at God's genius. It was also a reminder of Christ and Mary as we saw cosmologically the woman clothed with Sun and the stars beneath her feet. A perfect image of our Lady of Guadalupe.
